- 3. A greeting to someone you have romantic feelings for and plan to pursue
- 4. A greeting to your boss
- 5. A greeting to an extended family member
- 6. A greeting to someone you haven't seen in a long time
- 7. A greeting to someone you are not happy to see
- 8. A greeting to someone you don't want to talk to
- 9. A greeting to a famous person you are excited to be introduced to
- 10. A greeting to someone who has performed heroic feats in the defeat of the Corona Virus Extra Credit!

TOOLS:

- If you have a digital video camera or DSLR at home, feel free to use them. Most of you will use your cell phones to record this.
- Although there are plenty of places to post your video, we want to edit together a huge compilation of your ideas - so all the link to the video you produce needs to be linked in the box below.
