2. Develop substantial answers to the above questions based on the research you have completed. Familiarize yourself with the information.

3. Develop an intro and exit for the interview. This should include:

INTRO –

- Teaser / Who What Why When and Where
- Subjects Name
- Transition remark

EXIT –

- Transition
- Summative remark
- Your name and station ID

4. Practice the Interview

5. Acquire props and costumes for the interviewee

6. Develop a shot list for the director of the show.

7. Perform the interview on the assigned day.
